

Accessing Google Classroom from Home using Chrome

This guide will show you how to login and access google classroom via the student portal from home. This is intended for students that will be using Google Chrome on Windows or Mac.Chromebook users please refer to Appendix A as the process is simpler

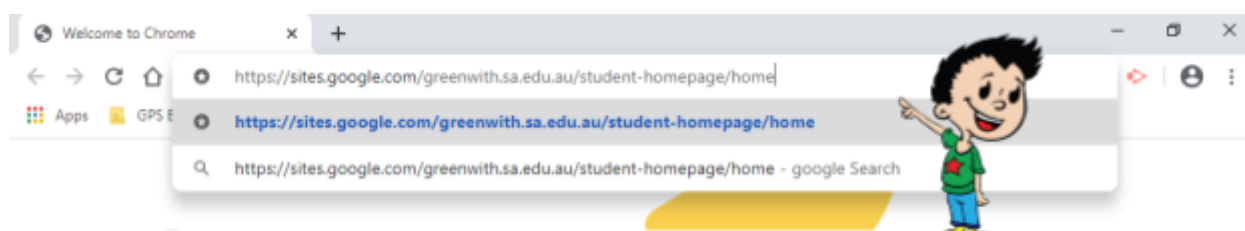

Step 01 - Visit the student portal page

Visit either

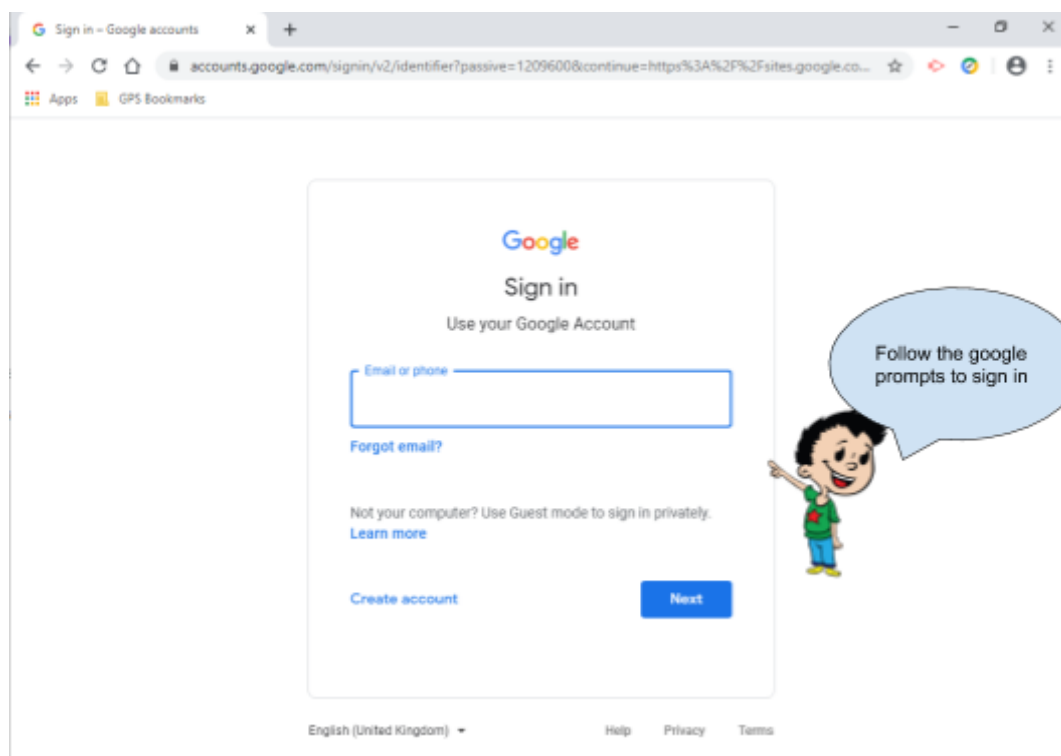

By typing them into the address bar of chrome



Step 02 - Sign in with your Greenwith Student Google account

NOTE: if you are already signed in you will skip this step, but make sure you are signed in with the correct Greenwith Student Google account, refer to Appendix B to check.



Step 03 - Click on the Classroom Icon

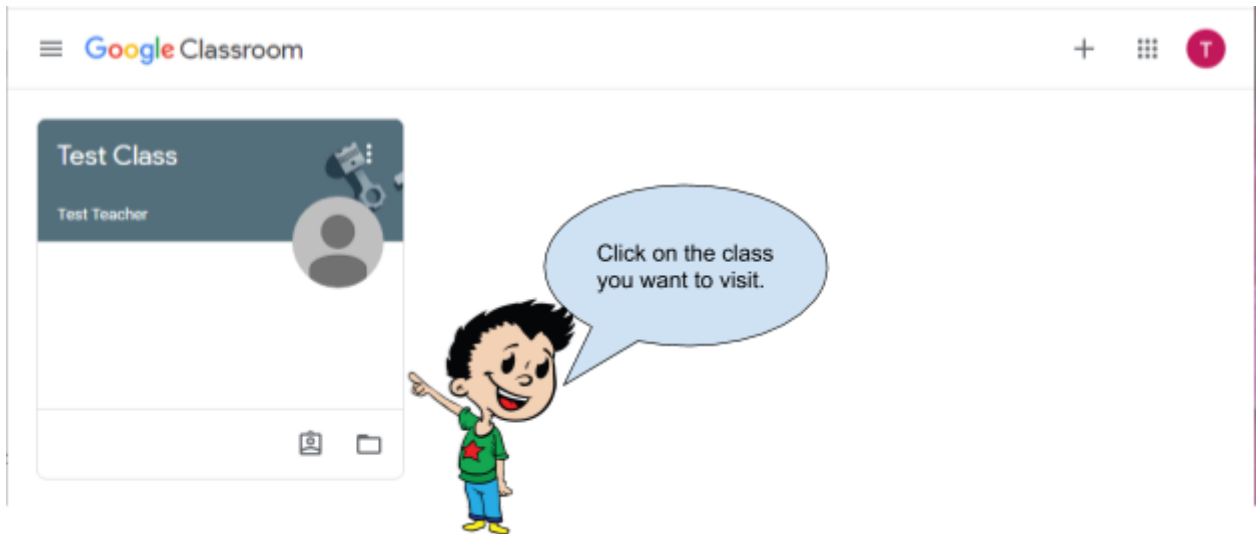
If you don't see the student portal or get an error, refer to Appendix B for troubleshooting

Step 04 - Click on your class

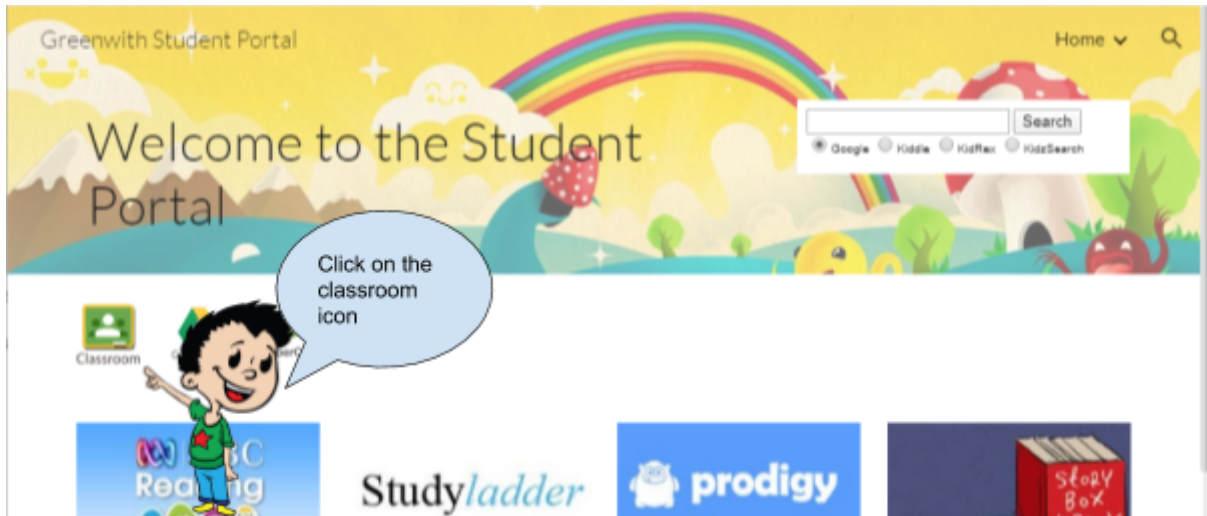
If you get an error, don't see your classes or the wrong classes, refer to Appendix B for troubleshooting.

1. Sign into your chromebook using your Greenwith Student Google account
2. When Chrome has loaded press the home button to visit the student portal
